## **CAT LEADER COMMITMENT:**

### **What are a CAT Leader's Responsibilities?**

- Attend monthly regional CAT Committee Meetings (West Bank, East Bank, Med Area, St. Paul)
- Each CAT Leader will take responsibility for 1-10 co-workers and will regularly follow up with them.
- Disseminate union info to their contacts.
- Identify new workers and get them to sign membership cards or let the local leadership know about them so they can meet them and get a membership card signed.
- Identify new temp workers and student workers hired into positions that should be clerical positions.
- Mobilize people in your work area to attend events and meetings.
- Identify problems that should be dealt with, either through grievances or through organizing campaigns.
- Make sure co-workers are receiving union e-mails and get them signed up on the Local 3800 Facebook page.
- Be knowledgeable about our rights in the workplace, and a resource for their co-workers.
- Be a good Union member, an advocate for our union, and show Solidarity with all workers!
