

## FACTS AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

### 1,000

The University has added more than 1,000 administrators since 2001. Of these, 400 positions were added since a hiring freeze/pause began in October 2008.

---

### 37%

The ranks of administration at the U grew more than 37% since 2001. That's more than twice as fast as faculty teaching positions, and nearly twice as fast as the student body.

---

### DOUBLED

Tuition for in state students has more than doubled in the past decade!

---

### \$2.8 million

\$2.8 million was paid out in golden parachutes to 10 University executives.

---

### 85 and -184

Between 2008 and 2012 senior administrator positions grew by 85, while 184 clerical positions (10% of the clerical workforce) were eliminated!

---

### RICH

The number of U of M employees earning above \$200,000 grew by 57% from the inflation-adjusted pay equivalent in 2001.

---

### RICHER

The number of administrators making above \$300,000 in inflation-adjusted terms has more than doubled (from 7 to 17).

---

### RICHEST

U of M President Eric Kaler has a salary of \$610,000 and his chief of staff is paid \$195,000. The Governor of Minnesota makes \$120,000.
